

Neusiok Trail - Day Hike #4

Deep Creek Road (FR 169) to Alligator Tram Road (FR 124). Distance 2.7 miles. Hike time 1 1/2 hours.

Two Car Shuttle:

1. Leave car one at trail crossing on Alligator Tram Road (FR 124). To get to Alligator Tram Road, follow Hwy 101 to Old Winberry Road (SR 1155). Follow Old Winberry Road South 1.3 miles toward Mill Creek to Alligator Tram Road (gravel road FR 124 on right). Carteret County Water tower is 0.2 mile South of FR 124. Drive 2.2 miles West on Alligator Tram Road to trail crossing. Trail sign is on left. Park on side of road.
2. Drive car two to Deep Creek Road (FR 169). To get to Deep Creek Road from Alligator Tram Road, follow Alligator Tram Road East 2.2 miles to Old Winberry Road (SR 1155). Turn left and follow Old Winberry Road North 1.3 miles to Hwy 101. Turn left (West) on Hwy 101 toward Harlowe. Follow Hwy 101 West 3.4 miles to East Lily Lodge. Turn left on Deep Creek Road (FR 169). Follow FR 169 gravel road South and continue straight 2.9 miles on Deep Creek Road. The trail crossing is 2.9 miles South of Hwy 101 on Deep Creek Road. Trail sign is on left. Park on side of road.
3. Hike South 2.7 miles to Alligator Tram Road. Follow CCWC silver tags or MST white circular blazes on trees.
4. Drive car one back to Deep Creek Road to retrieve car two.

Bicycle Shuttle Alternative:

1. Leave car at the trail crossing on the east end of Alligator Tram Road (FR 124). To get to Alligator Tram Road, follow Hwy 101 to Old Winberry Road (SR 1155). Follow Old Winberry Road South 1.3 miles toward Mill Creek to Alligator Tram Road (gravel road FR 124 on right). Carteret County Water tower is 0.2 mile South of FR 124. Drive 2.2 miles West on Alligator Tram Road to trail crossing. Trail sign is on left. Park on side of road.
2. Ride bicycle East 2.2 miles on Alligator Tram Road to Old Winberry Road (SR 1155). Turn left and follow Old Winberry North 1.3 miles to Hwy 101. Turn left (West) on Hwy 101. Follow Hwy 101 West 3.4 miles to East Lily Lodge. Turn left at FR 169. Follow gravel road FR 169 South 2.9 miles to trail crossing.
3. Secure bicycle at trail sign.
4. Hike South 2.7 miles to Alligator Tram Road. Follow CCWC silver tags or MST white circular blazes on trees.
5. Drive car back to Deep Creek Road to retrieve bicycle.
