

Mountains-to-Sea Trail Miles Designated 1283, 1282, 1282, 1283, 1283, 1283, 1282, 1283,






















MST Regional Plans

A series of regional meetings with stakeholders and land owners.


- Councils of Government

A Master Plan for the MST is Needed

- ✓ To unite the regional plans
- ✓ To clarify partner roles and strategies
- ✓ To add detailed site planning where needed to accelerate segment completion



Repository for all public information and activities for the MST master planning process





INFORMATION

- Overview of MST history and goals
- Status of planning and completion of the various trail segments
- Clarification of partner roles
- Identification of funding sources and strategies





PROMOTION

- Links from the map on the website to each segment for detailed information
- Standards and practices for coordinated publicity and marketing
- Standards and practices for safety, signs and mapping





PLANNING PROCESS

- Overall steps and schedule for planning process
- Online opportunities for public input, comments and review
- Overall plan for completion of incomplete trail segments





SCOPING MEETINGS

Interview future manager of each incomplete segment

Identify support, resources and obstacles

to completion





INFORMATION GATHERING

- Meet or talk with volunteers, partners, stakeholders, and managers of completed segments for ideas and input
- Website will be available for all to contribute ideas and comments





DEVELOP DRAFT MASTER PLAN

With information from interviews and meetings:

- Assess priority of each segment
- Group segments into logical subsections of 20-30 miles based on geography, topography, status
- Prioritize subsections for future planning and implementation
- Prepare draft standards and practices, funding sources, clarification of roles, and other general information







REVIEW AND FINALIZE DRAFT MASTER PLAN

- All partners and stakeholders will have opportunities to review and comment on the draft master plan developed from the scoping and information gathering phases
- Draft master plan will be revised based on comments received
